United Way Fox Cities Announces Major Gift to Fox Cities Habitat for Humanity's Neighborhood Revitalization Program

Menasha, Wis. - United Way Fox Cities will support the Greater Fox Cities Area Habitat for Humanity's Neighborhood Revitalization program with a gift of \$300,000. The grant, made possible through the generous support of community donors, will invest in neighborhoods struggling with decreasing property values and increasing number of rental properties. It will support Habitat's efforts to bring people together to improve the quality of life in targeted neighborhoods.

Habitat will kick off revitalization efforts in its first targeted neighborhood, near the former Pierce Manufacturing site in Appleton, with a Rock the Block® event from September 14 – 19. Then, over the next few years, Habitat will build new homes, rehab and repair homes and help develop neighborhood leaders there. The goal is to increase property values, maintain homeownership rates and restore pride in ownership. "Our United Way is committed to improving the lives of struggling low-income families and households and recognizes the importance of having safe stable housing in thriving neighborhoods

of the Fox Cities. The formation of this initiative will serve as a valuable resource and will strengthen the support systems available to help a growing number of low-income households to be more self-sufficient," said Peter Kelly, President and CEO of United Way Fox Cities.
