APPLETON - Voices of Men, a Fox Cities group for men working to end violence against women, has become a program of Goodwill Industries of North Central Wisconsin.

It's in good company — Goodwill now has 30 programs and services for the community, including the LGBT Partnership, FISC financial counseling, Circles of Support and [others](#). United Way Fox Cities was previously the fiscal agent for Voices of Men.

Voices of Men began in 2007 as a collaboration of four local domestic and sexual assault agencies and hosts an annual breakfast as well as year-round educational outlets for men and boys. Voices of Men's next breakfast is Nov. 2 and can be livestreamed for free from the group's [website](#).

"Goodwill NCW's mission of 'Elevating People, Transforming Communities' aligns seamlessly with our work," Voices of Men's Shannon Kenevan said in a released statement. "Voices of Men is elevating boys and men in our community by teaching healthy manhood, and we are

transforming communities by engaging more people in sexual assault and domestic violence prevention.”
