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CALUMET AND OUTAGAMIE COUNTIES TO RECEIVE FEDERAL FUNDING THROUGH THE EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER NATIONAL BOARD PROGRAM

APPLICATION DEADLINE SET

(MENASHA, WI) – The following two counties have been selected to receive Federal funding to supplement area emergency food and shelter programs: \$6,036 for Calumet County and \$17,860 for Outagamie County. These Federal funds are made available through the Department of Homeland Security (DHS)/Federal Emergency Management Agency under the Emergency Food and Shelter National Board Program.

A Local Board for the Emergency Food & Shelter Program, administered by United Way Fox Cities, will determine how the funds awarded to the counties are to be distributed among local emergency food and shelter programs.

Under the terms of the grant from the National Board, local agencies chosen to receive funds must: 1) be private voluntary non-profits or units of government, 2) be eligible to receive Federal funds, 3) have an accounting system, 4) practice nondiscrimination, 5) have demonstrated the capability to deliver emergency food and/or shelter programs, and 6) if they are a private voluntary organization, have a voluntary board.
